Technical Rider of the performance

Set up: 8 hours (with a rehearsal)

Striking time: not less than 1 hour

Stage size (minimum) : Width - 6 m, depth - 3 m, height – 3 m

Blackbox, no legs.

For a successful and quick setup please invite a sound engineer, a light operator and 2 Stage hands.

Light will be operated from the laptop with USB interface, which connects to the dimmer with 3-pin DMX cable.

Profile spotlights – 2 pc

Not less than 16 channels on the dimmer
